## Use of Eltham College Facilities

Impressive facilities  
available for hire

Eltham College is a beautiful building, based on a Georgian manor house and set in 60 acres of playing fields. It has a number of facilities which are available to be hired out for a range of events and activities, with or without catering.



## King George's Hall

A spacious dining hall with a capacity for up to 150 people

This large dining room, with its beautiful wooden panelled ceiling, is often hired for a wide range of functions including wedding receptions, charity balls and fundraising events.

The room can cater for a sit down reception of 150 people.

Catering is provided by our preferred caterers and there are a range of menus available.



## Central Hall

For smaller, more intimate events

For smaller gatherings, such as a drinks reception, this oak panelled room provides a cosy setting for parties of up to 60 people for a standing event.



## Chapel

For weddings, blessings and dedications

Positioned close to the Main House and adjacent to 60 acres of beautiful grounds, the chapel can be booked for weddings, blessings and dedications. Those considering using the chapel for such functions should contact the Chaplain via the school office at the earliest opportunity to confirm details.



## Summer Marquee

Set in front of the Main House in July and able to hold up to 400 people

Every summer at Eltham College, a large marquee is erected on the front lawns to host various school functions. It is possible to book this marquee for a wedding reception or other events during the month of July. The marquee can hold up to 400 people with space for a dance floor.



## Fees for hire of school facilities

The standard charges for the hire of the school facilities are as follows:

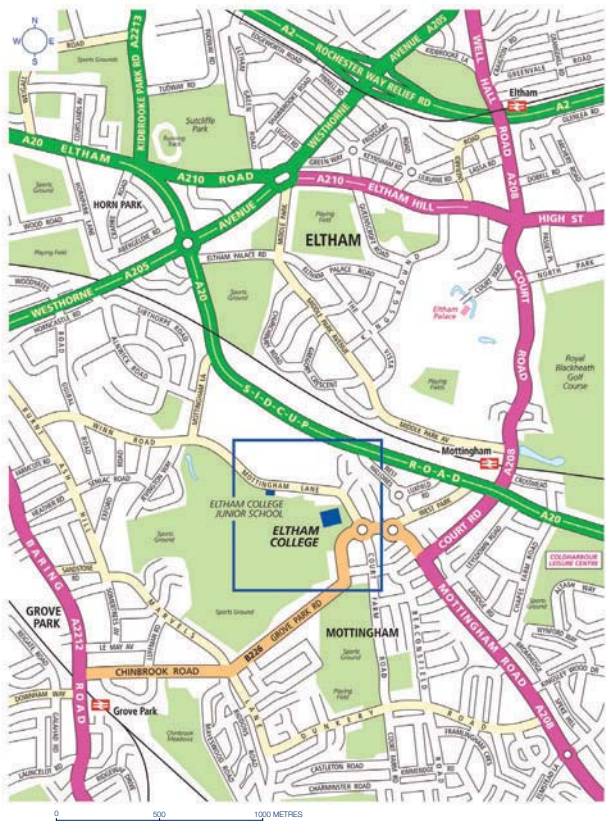
King George's Hall	£1,000 plus catering costs
Central Hall	£300 plus catering costs
Chapel	From £300
Summer Marquee	From £3,000 plus catering costs

## Travelling to Eltham College



**On Arrival:** Car Parking is limited adjacent to the Main Entrance, but more space is available by the Eric Liddell Sports Centre entrance from Mottingham Lane.

**By Rail:** The nearest main line stations are Mottingham (10 minutes walk) on the Central London to Dartford / Crayford line via Sidcup and Grove Park (8 minutes by taxi) on the Central London to Sevenoaks line via Orpington. Both have regular service connections to London and the Southeast.

**By Road: From the M25 & A2:** Leave the M25 at Junction 2 and join the A2 (signposted Dartford, London). Travel for approximately 10 miles and then leave the A2 via the slip road to join the A205 South Circular westwards (signposted Eltham). Continue straight across at the first roundabout and, at the second, turn left to join the A20, Sidcup Road. After approximately 1 mile turn right onto the A208, Court Road and at the T junction turn right onto the B226 which leads into Grove Park Road. Travel straight across two roundabouts and the entrance to Eltham College will be seen immediately on the right-hand side.

**From the M25 & A20:** Leave the M25 at Junction 3 and join the A20 (signposted Swanley, London). Travel for approximately 9 miles and then leave the A20 by turning left onto the A208, Court Road (signposted Mottingham). Travel to the T junction and turn right onto the B226 which leads into Grove Park Road. Travel straight across two roundabouts and the entrance to Eltham College will be seen immediately on the right-hand side.

**From the A205 South Circular:** Once on the South Circular follow signs towards Woolwich and the A20. Leave the South Circular, at Eltham via the roundabout, and join the A20, Sidcup Road (signposted Sidcup, Swanley). After approximately 1 mile turn right onto the A208, Court Road and at the T junction turn right onto the B226 which leads into Grove Park Road. Travel straight across two roundabouts and the entrance to Eltham College will be seen immediately on the right-hand side.

**By Air:** Gatwick (40 minutes by road) and Heathrow (60 minutes by road) airports are within easy reach of Eltham College via the M25, with regular scheduled flights to all UK, European and International destinations.
